Short-term missions is a long standing tradition among the men of The Alliance. We have organized and led teams to most of the countries where our missionaries serve.

#### Purpose

The purpose of short-term missions is to advance Christ's Kingdom overseas by providing assistance to our missionaries and national brothers and sisters in Christ.

#### Benefits

Meet the needs of overseas national churches, bless the churches and people with whom the team comes in contact.

#### Creative-Access Countries

While we cannot send teams of people into creative-access countries, we can

send individuals or couples to assist with worker needs. The focus of these visits should be related to ongoing tent making activities. This can include people with experience in marketing, business operations, accountants, medical or dental services, and agriculture.

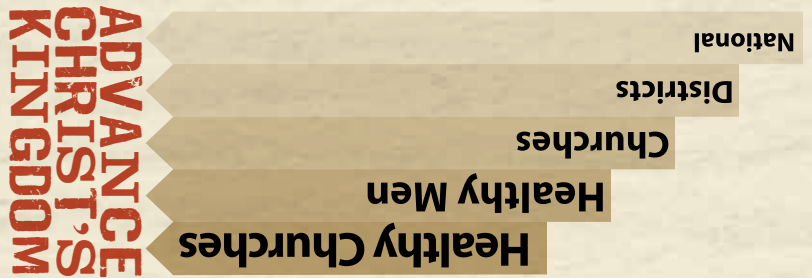
